Nesika Beach Preserve Conservation Easements & Acquisition

This coastal preserve was transferred from the Nature Conservancy to Wild Rivers Land Trust in 2020. The roughly 100-acre preserve contains a Sitka Spruce and Grand Fir forest as well as rare plants on the coastal bluffs that front the Pacific Ocean. The property is a collection of three conservation easements and a parcel of donated land south of Nesika Beach. As Wild Rivers Land Trust's second coastal property, Nesika Beach Preserve creates opportunities to do new types of restoration and stewardship work. It also advances our goal of providing connectivity from the "summit to seastacks" in our service

area. It is a great example of how good partnerships and being an accredited land trust is important for advancing conservation work on the South Coast.
